




## How to Create a Basket (Step-by-Step Instructions)



Welcome to the Hands-On Growing Basket kit!

Before you begin, make sure that you read over the Parts sheet to see how many numbers of parts belong to each letter.




Take out the basket pieces that you will be working with and make sure that you have all the pieces as stated in the Parts Sheet.



Take out the four (4) pieces labelled "A" and lay them in an intercrossed pattern as shown in the photo.

Make sure that the letters on the pieces are facing up.



Next, take the piece labelled "B" and overlap both ends together, making sure that the slots at the front and back match up and that the "B" is facing out.

Take one of the pieces labelled "D" and insert the strip into the top four slots, using a weaving pattern, as shown in the picture. Repeat with the bottom four slots and another D strip.



Take the piece labelled "C" and repeat the same step as for "B".

You should now have two (2) equal cylindrical pieces.



Take the circular "B" piece and place it in the center of the four (4) interlocked "A" pieces, making sure that the "B" is on the outside.



Take one of the flaps marked "A" and insert it inside the circular "B" piece as shown in the photo.



Continue alternating the "A" flaps all around the circular "B" piece (one flap inside and one outside, etc.) until all flaps have been used.



Take the circular piece labelled "C" and place on top of the bottom circular piece, making sure that the lettering is on the outside.



Take the "A" flaps and once again intertwine through the "C" circular piece as with the "B" circular piece.

When all flaps have been intertwined, make sure that the slots at the top are aligned.



Take the piece labelled "E" and with the slots at the top, start intertwining the strip as shown in the photos, going around the entire basket and making sure that there is about 4 - 5 " left over at each end when completed.



Take the ends and tie them on the inside of the basket.

Make sure that there are no gaping seams.

Congratulations! Your basket is now ready to go!
